



RULES AND REGULATIONS AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY RELAY FOR LIFE OF CHESHIRE June 9th & 10th, 2006

DO...

- ... put together a team of **at least 10 individuals** with one person on the track at all times
- ... check in at the registration tent prior to entering the track – 11:00am
- ... pay a **\$10.00 registration fee, per participant** – which must be paid prior to walking
- ... **raise a minimum of \$100.00 per person** and a minimum of \$1000.00 per 10 member team (this is a donation and not a pledge)
- ... pre-registered teams must turn in team registration information by **Fri April 16th, 2004** in order to be guaranteed a t-shirt
- ... take notice that there will be a period of quiet time during the night – please be considerate of others
- ... use gas and charcoal grills in designated areas only during times specified
- ... bring strollers and wheel chairs as needed
- ... play any games in the designated activity areas only
- ... bring children of all ages – anyone under the age of 21 will be the responsibility of a parent or chaperone (1 chaperone per 5 young adults). Parents or chaperones are required to be with the team throughout the entire 24 hours.
- ... youth participants must have wristband for the entire event.
- ... all adult participants must have wristband on after the luminary ceremony
- ... campsites will be chosen on a first come, first served basis only after a team has registered and paid their team registration fees
- ... report any injury or security issue to a Committee Member immediately

... remember, portions of the gym will “Not” be open for use of restrooms and showers (will be closed except during events that use the facility)

DO...

- ... park in designated areas only
- ... pick up your team’s trash and dispose of in receptacles that are provided (at close of event, your area should be totally clean)
- ... have a GREAT time!!!

DON'T...

- ... start any open fires
- ... forget to sign a waiver
- ... bring generators
- ... forget to bring your sneakers
- ... bring pets
- ... bring roller blades, skates, skateboards or bicycles
- ... forget your sunglasses & hat
- ... bring or drink alcohol of any kind
- ... forget to bring sunscreen
- ... smoke or chew any type of tobacco on school grounds, in tents or in any surrounding wooded areas
- ... forget to bring plenty of water
- ... have youths attend without a chaperone
